






| <p><b>Ghost Ray</b></p>  <p>(Click to enlarge)</p>               | <p>A weapon invented by the <b>Kektrish</b>; it atomizes the flesh of anything it touches, leaving only blackened bones; it was developed during the last <b>Kektrish Civil War</b>, and it was accidentally used to wipe out <b>Cratermoth</b>, an entire <b>Nephret</b> village close to the Kektrish border; the ray was then sabotaged by <b>Grawuul</b>, which brought the war to an end; when the <b>Strangers</b> invade, the Kektrish government pushes to re-deploy this weapon, which motivates Grawuul to form <b>WIT</b>.</p> | <p><u><a href="#">Cymetrodons:</a></u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <u><a href="#">All tracks</a></u></li> </ul>  |



| <p><b>Great Kektrys</b></p>  <p>(Click to enlarge)</p>     | <p>One of three populated continents on an alternate version of Earth where human beings never evolved from apes; it is home to the <b>Kektrish</b> crocodile people, and it was visited by the <b>Warlock</b> and the younger <b>Shieldmaiden of Set</b> during its ancient history.</p>  | <p><u><a href="#">The Scarlet Nemesis:</a></u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <a href="#">Mesozoic</a></li> </ul> <p><u><a href="#">Cymetrodons:</a></u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <a href="#">All tracks</a></li> </ul>  |
| <p><b>Great Witch Hunt</b></p>  <p>(Click to enlarge)</p> | <p>A pandemic of mass violence engineered by the <b>Warlock</b> to help the <b>Reverend President</b> in his rise to power; it is amplified by hexed television and radio signals, which the Warlock uses to keep the masses hypnotized; it specifically targets the <b>Church of Many Mothers</b>, who are deemed a “doomsday cult”; the <b>Sorceress</b> sends her bravest warriors to rescue as many church members across the nation as possible, bringing them to <b>New Sennebytos</b> for refuge; the social chaos that ensues from this Great Witch Hunt is what finally allows the <b>Ungod</b> to appear in our sky.</p> | <p><u><a href="#">Our Lady of Thrones:</a></u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <a href="#">The Reverend President</a></li> <li>• <a href="#">Satanic Panic (Disciple of the Worm)</a></li> <li>• <a href="#">Go With the Goddess</a></li> <li>• <a href="#">Escape to New Sennebytos</a></li> </ul>   |



| <p style="text-align: center;"><b>Halloween</b></p>  <p style="text-align: center;">(Click to enlarge)</p>     | <p>More than just a holiday, <b>Halloween</b> – also called <b>All Hallows' Eve</b>, the <b>Festival of Samhain</b>, and <b>Nos Calan Gaeaf</b> – is when the pathways between all universes are temporarily widened, causing one or more reality to “bleed” into one another; this makes it potentially easier for people to visit other worlds (whether intentionally or accidentally), as well as for beings from other worlds (e.g., <b>Fae</b>, aliens, the dead) to visit the Earth; hence why Halloween is the single most important date in <b>Wyrddham, PA</b>.</p> | <p><u><a href="#">Summer's End:</a></u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <a href="#">All tracks</a></li> </ul> <p><u><a href="#">Summer's End II:</a></u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <a href="#">All tracks</a></li> </ul> <p><u><a href="#">Summer's End III:</a></u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <a href="#">All tracks</a></li> </ul> <p><u><a href="#">Summer's End IV:</a></u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <a href="#">All tracks</a></li> </ul> |



| <p><b>Kektrish Civil War</b></p>  <p>(Click to enlarge)</p> | <p>The most recent of several civil wars that have plagued the history of <b>Great Kektrys</b>; during this conflict, one <b>Kektrish</b> faction invented the <b>Ghost Ray</b> and accidentally destroyed the <b>Nephret</b> village of <b>Cratermoth</b>; this nearly caused the war to become an international conflict; but it thankfully ended when <b>Grawuul</b> sabotaged the Ghost Ray, just before the story of <a href="#">Cymetrodons</a> begins.</p>   | <p><a href="#">Cymetrodons:</a></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <a href="#">All tracks</a></li> </ul>  |
| <p><b>Nephret</b></p>  <p>(Click to enlarge)</p>            | <p>One of three populated continents on an alternate version of Earth where human beings never evolved from apes; it is home to the <b>Nephret</b> frog people.</p>   | <p><a href="#">Cymetrodons:</a></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <a href="#">All tracks</a></li> </ul>  |

| <p><b>Quantamaker Process</b></p>  <p>(Click to enlarge)</p> | <p>A formula for physical immortality discovered by <b>Dr. Adam Quantamaker</b>; it renders the body ageless and physically indestructible, but it also annihilates the soul, resulting in the creation of the <b>Neverdead</b>; this research is funded by the <b>Warlock</b>, who appropriates the Neverdead for his own purposes; after the Warlock is defeated, the Neverdead are imprisoned by what remains of the <b>Quantamaker Group</b>, which now works to replicate their founder’s zombification formula.</p>  | <p><u><a href="#">The Scarlet Nemesis:</a></u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <a href="#">Graveyard Minds</a></li> </ul>  |

| <p><b>Stonehenge Tape</b></p>  <p>(Click to enlarge)</p>            | <p>A geological phenomenon unique to at least one version of Stonehenge across the multiverse; its monolithic stones can “record” events that occur within their vicinity; scientists from the <b>Quantamaker Group</b> discover how to “replay” these “recordings” by bouncing sound waves off the stones; the scientists then witness events from ancient prehistory that drive them insane; a digitized copy of this “Stonehenge Tape” is now preserved at the Quantamaker Group’s secret headquarters, where Group scientists are currently working to weaponize the tape’s effects.</p> | <p><u><a href="#">Summer's End II:</a></u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <u><a href="#">The Stonehenge Tape</a></u></li> </ul>   |
